Trash Disposal

City residents should contact the City Hall at 568-3032 or the Street Department at 568-2811.

All "pick-up" garbage shall be contained within the orange garbage bags or the garbage carts. Dumpsters may be ordered through City Hall for disposal of excess quantities.

Demolition Waste

- The recycling center accepts lumber, plywood, pallets, drywall, etc. City residents should check in with attendant before unloading for a quote to dispose of.

Yard Waste

City residents should contact the Street Department at 568-2811 or ask the recycling center attendant for disposal information; see the map for location of the yard waste drop-off.

Residential Guidelines for Recycling Materials

Newspapers & Phone books

Newspaper, phone books, and similar materials.

- Bundle newspaper and tie with string or place in paper grocery sacks.
- Shiny inserts may be included.

Magazines, Catalogs, & Office Paper

- Magazines and office paper are accepted but must be kept separate from each other. (Catalogs may be included with magazines.)

Cardboard & Paper Grocery Bags

- Flatten boxes.
- Remove all styrofoam.
- No gray paperboard boxes, cereal boxes, shiny milk cartons, or oil soaked cardboard; including Christmas paper and gift boxes.

Glass Bottles & Jars

- Do not break glass bottles or jars.
- Deposit clear, green or brown glass only.
- Remove caps and metal rings.
- Labels may be left on.
- **No window glass, light bulbs, dishes, mirrors, or candle glass.**
- Separate by color (green & blue can go together).

Aluminum Cans

- Rinse clean.
- Other aluminum may also be deposited.

Steel/Tin Cans

- Rinse clean.
- Flatten, if possible to conserve space.
- Empty aerosol cans are also accepted.



Plastic Bottles #1 - #2

- Rinse clean – remove caps.
- Flatten to conserve space.

Appliances

- Appliances will be accepted at the recycling center for residents of the City of Bloomer and Towns of Auburn, Bloomer, and Woodmohr. **Residents of the Town of Sampson must pay a fee of \$15.**
- Registration and proof of residency is required.
- The following appliances have been banned from Wisconsin landfills and will be accepted at the recycling center:

Refrigerators	Freezers	Furnaces
Ovens	Dehumidifiers	Microwaves
Dryers	Dishwashers	Air conditioners
Washers	Disposals	Water heaters
Trash compactors		Heat pumps

Scrap Metal

Scrap metal items are accepted including sheet metal, aluminum windows, fencing, lawn mowers, car parts, aluminum, steel siding, wire, copper tubing, and electric motors.

Used Automotive Oil & Batteries

- Used automotive oil and used automotive batteries will be accepted.
- **No bulk oil**

PLEASE RINSE CONTAINERS!!

Un-rinsed food containers are a health hazard because they attract insects and rodents.

Fluorescent Light Bulbs

Fluorescent bulbs have a small amount of mercury vapor in them. Mercury is a neuro-toxin and therefore fluorescent bulbs are declared a universal waste by the DNR and **must** be recycled.



Carpet Padding & Cushions

- Clean, dry urethane carpet, padding and seat cushions are accepted.
- Glued or rubber-backed carpet will **not** be accepted.
- No commercial drop off.

Electronics/TVs

Free for City of Bloomer and Towns of Auburn and Woodmohr residents. Town of Sampson residents are charged \$15 per appliance.
